



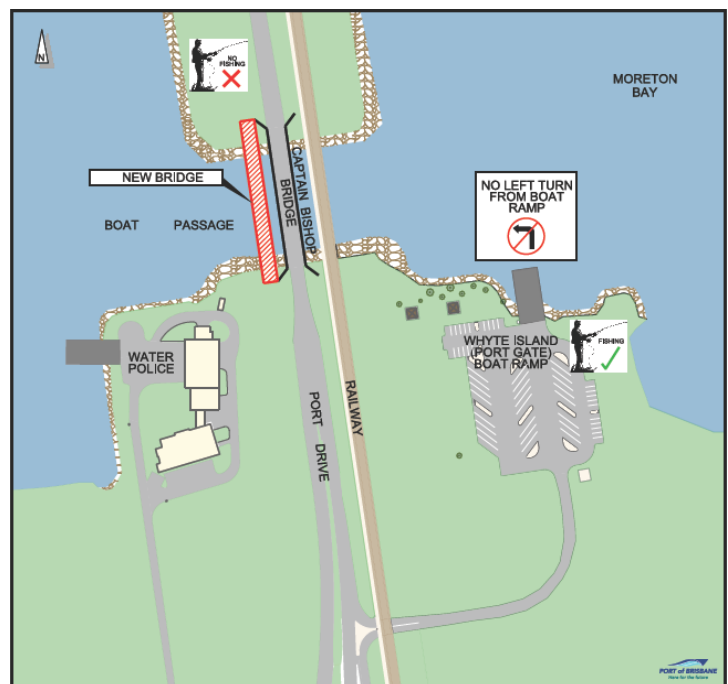
Closure of the Boat Passage

From August 2010, boating access through the Boat Passage between the Whyte Island Boat Ramp and the Brisbane River will be closed a number of times over a 12 month period. These closures will not occur over the weekend.

The closures are necessary for safety reasons associated with the duplication of the Captain Bishop Bridge. The duplication of the bridge and associated road works will cater for the increasing traffic and trade demands at the Port of Brisbane.

PBC regrets the inconvenience to the boating community in the temporary closure of the Boat Passage, during the construction period.

Boating access to the Brisbane River is available via the Pinkenba Boat Ramp (north side) and Colmslie Boat Ramp (south side).
